RE: Planned Parenthood of Kansas & Mid-Missouri To Hold Press Briefing on the Kansas Supreme Court Hearing Regarding Sweeping Invasion of Patients' Medical Privacy by Kansas Attorney General

Overland Park, KS – The Kansas Supreme Court will hear oral arguments on September 8th on the appeal by abortion providers to protect the privacy of women whose medical records have been subpoenaed as part of an “inquisition” pursued by anti-choice Kansas Attorney General Phill Kline. The subpoenas were first served secretly in September 2004 and became public in February 2005.

Comprehensive Health of Planned Parenthood of Kansas & Mid-Missouri will hold a press briefing in Topeka at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, September 1, to provide information on the background of the case, the issues involved and its efforts to protect the women and their medical privacy.
