

Overview of Services

Planned Parenthood of Kansas and Mid-Missouri (PPKM) provides a broad range of reproductive health care services, education and advocacy. PPKM, headquartered in Overland Park, Kansas, has 12 clinics across Kansas and Missouri. We offer services in Lawrence, Wichita and Hays, Kansas, and at nine Missouri clinics, in Kansas City, Warrensburg, Sedalia, Columbia, Jefferson City and Grandview.

Medical Services

PPKM's medical services include:

- family planning and contraception
- pregnancy testing
- HIV testing
- treatment of sexually transmitted infections
- detection of cervical, breast and testicular cancers, and
- detection of sickle cell anemia.

Sixty-eight percent of our patients receive some subsidy for their care, and no family planning patient is ever turned away because of an inability to pay.

- Abortion services are provided by our affiliate organization, **Comprehensive Health of Planned Parenthood** of Kansas and Mid-Missouri.

Advocacy

PPKM monitors public policy at local, state and national levels that pertains to reproductive health services and freedoms. With the assistance of hundreds of volunteers, PPKM supports public policies that are consistent with our mission of assuring that people can make and act on their own decisions regarding whether and when to have children.

Education

PPKM offers sexuality education to Kansas City area schools, religious institutions and community organizations. We provide age-appropriate, interactive presentations on 13 topics that give young people information about reproductive health and sexuality and help them make informed decisions about relationships and sexual behaviors.

In addition, PPKM works to improve parent-and-child communication through "Talking With Your Kids about Sex" workshops for youths in grades 4 through 10 and their parents.

Our Suzanne E. Allen Resource Library provides public access to brochures, books and videos on a variety of topics related to sexuality, reproductive health and reproductive rights.
